Carol is also part of an invitational exhibit at the Spirol Gallery, QVCC in Danielson, opening February 25 and continuing thru March 31--this exhibit is showcasing alternative photography methods and mixed media utilizing photography.

• **Gigi Liverant** will be exhibiting in a show at Hartford Fine Art, "ART FROM THE HEART". This is a fund-raiser for the American Heart Association that coincides with their GO RED FOR WOMEN campaign. They will attend intensive professional development sessions in February 2010, and, working in pairs, will co-conduct a 12-day Teacher Artist Collaboration (TAC) in a CCT Higher Order Thinking (HOT) School. TACs are high level 12-day residencies that are developed and implemented collaboratively with classroom teachers.
