Gallery hours are Friday 6-9 pm, Saturday 1-7 pm, and by appointment. Carol's large mixed media landscape paintings focus on the high desert plateaus, mesas, and canyons of northern Arizona and southern Utah where she grew up. The *Across the Canyon* paintings are composed of oil paints, ground minerals, powdered earth pigments, iron oxide, silver, chalk, clay, and charcoal--literally the "stuff" of the earth.
